

Karate Instructor

Overview:

This position is part time under the direct supervision of the Recreational Sports Specialist. The instructor is responsible for instructing Adult & Youth Karate classes on Monday & Wednesday evenings. The Karate instructor is also responsible for creating and instructing class curriculum and keeping and reporting class attendance to the Recreational Sports Specialist.

Responsibilities

1. The Karate instructor is responsible for creating and instructing appropriate class curriculum for youth and adults that keep with the ancient martial art form of Karate.
2. Ensure participants are safely utilizing all equipment, wearing appropriate athletic attire/uniform and complying with class policies.
3. The Karate instructor shall attend all class sessions in which they shall monitor and teach participants and volunteers. The instructor shall also ensure that spectators follow stated policies while present at classes/clinics.
4. Shall ensure all The Salvation Army Kroc Center policies and procedures are implemented and followed.
5. Serve as a first responder – provide emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services, based upon their level of training/certification.
6. Keep and report attendance, rankings, and other pertinent stats to the Recreational Sports Specialist on a regular basis as directed, while filling out administrative paperwork including accident and incident reports and program summaries.

Qualifications

Education & Certifications: High school degree or equivalent. Possess or obtain CPR, First Aid and AED certifications within 60 days of employment.

Experience:

- Some work experience as a Karate instructor required.
- Karate Black Belt Certification required
- Combination of education and related work experience will be considered.
